Taliban announces death of Jalaluddin Haqqani

Jalaluddin Haqqani, whose death was announced by the Afghan Taliban on Tuesday, was the founder of the dreaded Haqqani Network which is believed to be behind a campaign of violence throughout Afghanistan including the 2008 bombing of the Indian Embassy in Kabul that killed 58 people.

The Afghan Taliban did not share the exact date of death or burial of the militant commander, who had resigned the operational leadership of the group in his son Sirajuddin Haqqani after the 9/11 attack.

"Well known Mujahid, famous Islamic scholar, renowned fighter, leader of Mujahideen, minister of frontiers in (Taliban) Islamic Emirate and member of Leadership (Taliban) Council, al-Hajj Mullah Jalaluddin Haqqani has died after long illness," the Afghan Taliban said in statement.

He was believed to be in his eighties and several times in the past news of his death was circulated but it was not confirmed by the militant group.

Jalaluddin studied at the Darul Uloom Haqqania Nowsheen in Pakistan's Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province. Islamic missionary and scholar at the University of Jihad as his alumnus include slain Taliban chiefs Mullah Omar and Mullah Akhtar Mansoor and Al-Qaeda.

He belonged to Afghanistan's Paktika province, bordering Pakistan, and rose to prominence during the Afghan war against Soviet forces in 1980s. He was appointed as minister in the Taliban government that ruled Afghanistan in 1990s.

Jalaluddin, who maintained his independent position during the Taliban regime, enjoyed close ties with Pakistan's army - Inter Services Intelligence (ISI).

In 2012, the US designated the Haqqani network as a terrorist organisation. Three years later, Pakistan also banned the Haqqani network as part of its National Action Plan.

The group is the bone of contention between Pakistan and the US as the latter accuses Haqqani militants were still using Pakistani soil to launch attacks - a charge denied by Pakistan.

Arif Alvi, a close ally of Prime Minister Imran Khan and one of the founding members of the Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf party, was elected as the new President of Pakistan Tuesday as the cricket-turned-politician consolidated his grip on power.

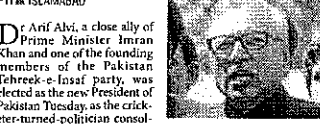
The 69-year-old former dentist defeated Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf candidate Aftab Khan and the Pakistan Muslim League-N nominee Maulana Fazlur Rahman in a three-way race to become the 13th President.

Of the 30 votes cast via a secret ballot in the National Assembly and Senate, Alvi received 212 votes, Rehman bagged 131 and Aftab Khan 63. Six votes were rejected.

Alvi secured 45 of the 60 votes cast by the Balochistan's newly elected lawmakers, it said. He is a PML-N MP from the 10th constituency, Aftab Khan secured 100 votes, while Aftab Khan 63. Just a solitary vote was cast in the favour of Rehman.

In Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Assembly, Alvi received 78 of the total 109 votes, while Rehman and Aftab got 26 and five votes respectively. In Punjab Assembly, Alvi secured 185 votes, while Rehman and Aftab received 141 and 6 votes respectively. 18 votes were rejected.

In his victory speech, Alvi thanked Prime Minister Khan for nominating "me for such a big responsibility."

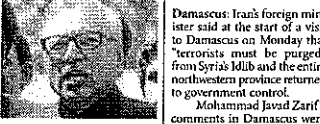
Alvi said that "from today I am not just president but I am the president of the entire nation and all parties. Each party has an equal right on me."

The newly elected president will take oath of the office on September 9, Outgoing President Muhammad Haseen Ali will continue to serve for a five-year tenure ends on September 8. Alvi said he will invite everyone, including the opposition, for the oath-taking ceremony.

His political struggle dates back to 1967, since the time of Ayub Khan. However, I believe that this nation has gained much awareness since the 1970s. I hope this nation will never be promised in the Constitution," he said.

Alvi is one of the founding members of PML. He served as the party's secretary general from 2006 to 2013.

He won the National Assembly elections from NA-247 (Karachi) during the July 25 polls. He was also elected member of the National Assembly in the 2013 general election.

Terrorists must be purged from Syria's Idlib, says Zarif

Damascus: Iran's foreign minister said at the start of a visit to Damascus on Monday that "terrorists must be purged" from Syria's Idlib and the entire northwestern province returned to government control.

Mohammad Javad Zarif's comments in Iran's semi-official Fars news agency and came as Syrian forces and their allies are preparing for an assault on Idlib, the last opposition stronghold in the country.

"Syria's territorial integrity should be safeguarded and all tribes and groups, as one society, should start the reconstruction process, and the refugees should return to their homes," Zarif said.

He met with Syrian President Bashar Assad and his Foreign Minister, Walid al-Moallem, who is just back from a visit to Moscow. The visit comes days before the leaders of Iran, Turkey, and Russia are expected to meet in Iran to discuss the situation in Idlib.

Myanmar defends Suu Kyi's silence over jailed reporters

Yangon: A global outcry over the jailing of two Reuters journalists in Myanmar has been greeted with silence by civilian leader Aung San Suu Kyi, a strong response that an official defended Tuesday as a necessary stance to criticise the judiciary.

Journalists Wa Lone, 32, and Kyaw Soe Oo, 28, were arrested while reporting on atrocities committed during the violent expulsion by the military of some 700,000 Rohingya Muslims last year.

A Yangon court on Monday found them guilty under the Official Secrets Act and handed them each seven years in prison, sparking outrage from the UN, EU and US.

All of whom supported Myanmar's emergence from decades of junta rule - as well as media and rights groups.

Suu Kyi, who herself subjected to house arrest for some 15 years, relying on foreign aid to highlight her plight, has been widely condemned for her silence on the case and verdict, which has posed the sternest test in recent years to free speech in the country.

Reuters journalist who now works for the government as deputy Minister of Information, defended the Nobel Laureate's reticence.

"Criticising the judicial system is not the intention of the content of court," he told AFP, explaining her silence so far. "I don't think she will do it."

Lawyers for the pair will appeal the verdict while ultimately the country's president, a close ally of Suu Kyi, can pardon prisoners. In April the president granted amnesty, including 36 deemed political prisoners.

But there were still some 200 Reuters journalists, facing trials linked to political activities, the Association for Free Political Prisoners said at the time. Erstwhile Suu Kyi advocates overseas have been dismayed by her attitude to their case so far. One public reference to the Reuters journalists during the court case - telling Japanese broadcaster NHK that the pair had broken the official secrets act - was criticised by rights groups for potentially prejudicing the verdict.
