

# Different shots given to six in jab mix-up in J'khand

**Palamu (Jharkhand):** Six people in Jharkhand's Palamu district were administered Covishield vaccine as their second dose against coronavirus on Wednesday, though they had received a shot of Covaxin as the first, an official said.

This happened because of a mistake, but the change in the vaccine will not have any significant negative effect on them, Chief Medical Officer of the district, Dr Anil Kumar Singh, said.

"Those six people went to a community health centre at Hariharganj to receive their sec-

ond dose of Covaxin. However, they were given Covishield due to lapse on the part of the employees there," Singh said.

They will be under observation for 24 hours. The six will have to take the second dose of Covishield, the official said.

After the mix-up was noticed, there was a commotion at the centre and police personnel have been deputed at the spot. Chhatrapur Sub-Divisional Police Officer Ajay Kumar said that police and civil officials reached the spot and brought the situation under control. **PTI**

# K'taka launches 2,500 smart classrooms, distributes Tablet PCs to 1.55 lakh students

**Bengaluru:** Karnataka Chief Minister B S Yediyurappa on Wednesday rolled out initiatives to promote digital learning and bridge the digital divide in higher education at a cost of about Rs 195 crore.

The initiatives include distributing Tablet PCs to 1.55 lakh students amounting to Rs 163 crore; creation of 2,500 smart classrooms at Rs 27.77 crore; and development of a learning management system (LMS) at ₹4.04 crore, an official release said.

"The programme is beneficial in moulding the future of the students. Smart classes will include projectors, white board, Android box, UPS and internet facility which will facilitate both teaching and learning," the Chief Minister was quoted as saying by his office in a release.

Despite the impediment caused by the Covid-19 pandemic, he said the government has made efforts to scientifically implement the digital learning programme in

# Adani group to operate Navi Mumbai Int'l airport

The Maharashtra Government on Wednesday approved a change in ownership of the company from M/s GVK Airport Developers Developers Limited to M/s Adani Airport Holdings Ltd (AAHL) to develop and operate the upcoming Navi Mumbai International Airport (NMIA) in the adjoining Thane-Raigad region.

At its weekly meeting, the State Cabinet – presided over by chief minister Uddhav Thackeray—gave a go ahead to AAHL to be the new concessionaire for the prestigious greenfield airport being developed as a public-private partnership (PPP) project.

Earlier, the airport was to be developed by GVK which was running the Mumbai International Airport Ltd (MIAL). However, the MIAL was taken over last year by AAHL and the same was

approved by the Directorate of Civil Aviation, Airports Authority of India, SEBI, CCI and finally the CIDCO, which is overseeing the mega-project.

With the state government's approval, the Gautam Adani-headed AAHL becomes the biggest private airport operator running several major airports like Mumbai, Navi Mumbai (proposed), Bengaluru, Ahmedabad and Lucknow, besides three more likely in the near future. A wholly-owned subsidiary of Adani Enterprises Ltd. (AEHL), the AAHL now has a majority stake in the new airport, with 26 percent belonging to the AAI.

Being developed on 1,160 hectares of land, Mumbai International Airport is expected to become operational in 2023-2024. When opened, it will become the country's leading airport over the next decade for both domestic and international flights.

# In jungle raj, safety of women in God's hands: Priyanka slams UP Govt

**New Delhi:** Hitting out at the BJP Government in Uttar Pradesh over the issue of crime against women, Congress leader Priyanka Gandhi Vadra on Wednesday said that in "jungle raj" women's safety is in God's hands.

The Congress general secretary alleged that such crimes are being committed against women in Uttar Pradesh which would make "one's soul tremble", but the Government is "sleeping".

"In Mathura, goons who had been harassing a girl for a year entered her house and threw her from the terrace. A girl, troubled over being teased, ended her own life in Hamirpur," she said in a tweet in Hindi. "In jungle raj, the safety of women is in God's hands," Priyanka Gandhi added.

Her attack on the government came after three men barged into the house of a 17-year-old girl on Tuesday and allegedly threw her off the second floor of the building. **PTI**

Commenting on the possible outcome of the meeting, political analyst Prof Hari Om observed, "The constituents of the Peoples Alliance for Gupkar Declaration have raised the bar too high for the Prime Minister to concede anything under the prevailing circumstances."

Prof Hari Om said those who are battling in support of restoration of Article 370, which granted special status to the erstwhile state of Jammu and Kashmir, will come out of the meeting empty handed.

Prof Hari Om said, "The mood of the nation is against any

concession as any U-turn on the part of New Delhi would be construed as a major concession to Pakistan. The demands put forth by the Gupkar Alliance - Article 35A, Article 370, full State status, reunion of Ladakh with J&K and special status - are extraordinary demands. Pakistan is also parrotting the same agenda to pin down India. "None of the five demands could be conceded by the PM without the approval of the Parliament or without amending the Indian Constitution. Besides, his Government has to render the J&K Reorganization Act, 2019 (Act No. 34 of 2019) unreal and ineffective and only the Parliament could do it," commented Prof Hari Om.

However, Guleria said that right now, the spread of Delta Plus variant is limited in India and we need to continue to be cautious. On Tuesday, the Union Health Ministry had announced that 22 cases of Delta Plus variant have been detected in India. The cases of Delta Plus have been found in genome sequenced samples from Ratnagiri and Jalgaon Districts of Maharashtra; Palakkad and Pathanamthitta Districts of Kerala; and Bhopal and Shivpuri Districts of Madhya Pradesh.

Recently, World Health Organisation (WHO) Chief Scientist Soumya Swaminathan had warned that the Delta variant is "well on its way" to becoming the dominant variant globally. However, Dr Rahul Bhargava, Director-Bone Marrow Transplant Program, Fortis Memorial Research Institute, Gurgaon, stressed "on knowing the infectivity rate of Delta plus variant and chances it can evade the fully-immunised person." Mask, vaccination and genomic surveillance are the cornerstone for prevention, he tweeted.

Flagging the concern, Dr Arvinder Singh Soin, chairman, Medanta Transplant Institute said that the Delta Plus - a variant of concern, is more transmissible and could even escape vaccines. "We will continue to learn more about it. For now, remember that new variant or old, Covid-appropriate behaviour stays the same," Soin said in his tweet.

His remarks came while replying to a question during a discussion on the theme "Looking towards peace in Afghanistan after the US-NATO withdrawal."

"I see the reason behind having a dialogue or talks or reaching out to all parties in Afghanistan but it is important to keep in mind that we are in a critical stage at this time, and I think if any meeting is going to take place, it should be for a major or main reason, which is to encourage the parties to solve their differences by peaceful means," al-Qahtani said.

Recently, External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar made two stop-overs in Doha during his visits to Kuwait and Kenya.

In his talks with senior Qatari leaders in Doha, the issue of

Afghanistan was discussed. Jaishankar also held talks on the issue with US Special Representative for Afghanistan Reconciliation Zalmay Khalilzad who was also there in the Qatari capital. The Government is yet to react to the Qatari diplomat's comments. Earlier this month, MEA Spokesperson Arindam Bagchi said that India is in touch with various stakeholders in Afghanistan in pursuance of its long-term commitment towards peace, development and reconstruction of that country.

In what could be a summing up of the Indian concerns on the Afghan issue, Foreign Secretary Harsh Vardhan Shringla had last week said that the Taliban's relentless pursuit of power through violence has created an uncertain environment in Afghanistan and the situation in the country is "fluid" at this point in time.

He said the SP was targeting 350 of UP's 403 seats in the crucial election that is widely seen as a test of voters' pulse ahead of the 2024 national election, when Prime Minister Narendra Modi's BJP will seek re-election and a third straight term in power.

"The BJP is going to lose the upcoming UP elections... they failed the people of UP in the biggest test of their leadership. People were abandoned by the Government. The so-called double-engine government - at the Centre and in UP - is going in different directions," he said.

The former Chief Minister downplayed the "Modi factor" and its potential impact on the UP campaign, flagging the infighting and dissidence against Yogi Adityanath over the past few months. Referring to Modi's close aide AK Sharma settling for a party post after much hype about his UP assignment, Akhilesh remarked, "Dilli wale log usko mantra nahin bana paye , unkp

uttar Pradesh mein vote kaun dega " (Delhi couldn't even make him Minister, who will vote for them ?). The BJP would defeat the BJP in UP, he quipped.

Targeting the Yogi Government's handling of the Covid crisis in the State, especially in the second surge, Akhilesh accused the Government of hiding the true figures of deaths. The SP chief also sought to explain a controversial remark that he made on "not taking the BJP vaccine", a reference to Bharat Biotech's Covaxin that was cleared for use while still in clinical trials.

"I had only refused to take the vaccine initially because it had not completed all the trials," Akhilesh said to allegations that his comments added to vaccine hesitancy in UP. On when he planned to take the shot, he kept it open-ended and said: "I have told the UP government that if it is able to vaccinate all the poor free of cost by Diwali, I will take the vaccine." He dismissed the risks involved in delaying vaccination.

"I had Covid in April and scientifically, am safe for three months at least," he said, asserting that his father and former Chief Minister Mulayam Singh Yadav had been vaccinated.

Supporting the Speaker's contention, senior TMC MLA Tapas Roy said, "Biman has done the right thing by bringing it to the notice of the Lok Sabha Speaker so that even he can see how democratically our Governor has been working."

Reacting to the issue CPI(M) central committee member Sujan Chakrabarty, however, held both the sides guilty of failing to accommodate each other. "During our times also we had a Governor

like Gopal Krishna Gandhi who was known for his partisan ways ... still Chief Minister Buddhadeb Bhattacharjee accommodated with him and such peculiar situations were avoided," he said.

However Bengal BJP president Dilip Ghosh said the Governor was stopping only those Bills which are not worthy to be passed. "The TMC is trying to bulldoze its way with certain Bills ... the Governor is only exposing the party's lawlessness."
