

Manohar Lal Khattar's Govt wins trust vote comfortably

The BJP-JJP Government in Haryana did not have any difficulty on the floor test on Wednesday, comfortably defeating the no-confidence motion moved against it by the main opposition Congress. The motion was defeated following division of votes.

At the end of a marathon six-hour discussion on the motion, Speaker Gian Chandra Gupta announced in the House that 55 members had voted against the motion while 32 legislators had backed it.

In place of secret voting, which former Chief Minister Bhupinder Singh Hooda had earlier demanded in the House, the Speaker first asked the members favouring the motion to rise from their seats and those against it were asked to stand. A headcount was done later. The 55 members who voted against the motion included 39 from the BJP, 10 of ally Janjany Janta Party, five

Independents and Gopal Kanda from Haryana Lokhit Party.

The BJP has 40 members in the Assembly which includes the Speaker.

Thirty members of the Congress and two Independents - Balraj Kundu and Somnath Sanyal - who had earlier withdrawn support, backed the motion. The opposition camp would have needed 45 members to win the no confidence motion.

In the 90-member Haryana Assembly, currently having an effective strength of 88 members, the ruling BJP has 40 members, the JJP 10 and the Congress 30. Seven are Independents, five of whom are supporting the government, members favouring the motion to rise from their seats and those against it were asked to stand. A headcount was done later. The 55 members who voted against the motion included 39 from the BJP, 10 of ally Janjany Janta Party, five

ment faced. Leader of Opposition Hooda claimed ruling dispensation has lost people's trust. He also said it would expose those who were claiming to stand in favour of farmers if they vote against the motion.

Referring to farmers protesting in Delhi's borders against the Centre's new farm laws for more than 100 days, Chief Minister Khattar reached out to opposition telling them that they should stop instigating the peasants and come forward and tell farmers to end their agitation.

Deputy Chief Minister and JJP leader Dushyant Chautala sought to assure that the government will protect the interests of farmers. He said MSP will continue, notwithstanding opposition's misleading claims.

After the end of the Question Hour, the Speaker admitted the notice of no-confidence motion against the

Council of Ministers and reserved two hour for discussion on it. However, less than many members speaking on it, the discussion went on for six hours.

Earlier, touching upon the issue of farmers who are protesting against the Centre's farm laws, Hooda said the situation is such that ruling dispensation MLAs cannot even visit their constituencies. "This government has lost the confidence of people. Their MLAs cannot go in their constituencies," he said. On one farmers issue, Hooda demanded inclusion of nearly 250 farmers, who have died during their ongoing agitation, in the obituary references of the Haryana Assembly.

Navjot Singh Sidhu claimed it was the BJP-JJP government which stopped farmers, used water cannons and even dug roads so that they could not march towards Delhi in November. "The government should know it cannot

break farmers by such tactics," he said. Hooda said farmers and their family members including women, children are sitting at the protest sites in Delhi Haryana borders and their sons are serving the nation at the border.

Lashing out at BJP leaders, senior Congress leaders alleged "Some leaders say only Punjab farmers are protesting against agri-laws; Khalistanis, Pakistanis, Chinese agenda behind farmers' agitation...." He said farmers from several states including Uttarakhand, Madhya Pradesh, Punjab, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh and Haryana are sitting on various border points of Delhi.

He said that the state government has "lost" trust of farmers and that the BJP-JJP government is not making it clear who stands with farmers and who is against them. "Entry boards have been put up outside villages banning entry of BJP and JJP leaders while Khap Panchayats have given social boycott calls. Never before in history has it happened before that the chief minister and deputy CMs helicopter are not being allowed to land in villages," said Kadian.

Farmers are sitting on borders, and the Gujjar hit out at the government for not inviting them for talks," he alleged. Kadian said MLAs of JJP, which had fought the 2019 assembly polls against the BJP before forging alliance with the saffron party, should look into their inner conscience

and support the no-confidence motion. Pointing towards JJP MLA Naina Chautala, who is also mother of Deputy Chief Minister Dushyant Chautala, Kadian asked her to rise like "Jhansi ki Rani" for farmers' cause and support the no-confidence motion. "Chaudhary Devi Lal dedicated his entire life for farmers' cause. The JJP leaders should look in their inner conscience before voting," he said, adding that the Deputy CM should withdraw support from the government and stand with farmers.

Ishwar Singh said the Government has taken several steps for welfare of farmers and brought many schemes for them. He said adequate arrangements are made by the Government to ensure smooth procurement of farmers' crops. Taking a dig at Congress leader, he said they were portraying themselves as if they were the only sympathisers of farmers. Ishwar Singh's speech was frequently interrupted by Congress members who asked him to make his stand clear whether he stood in support of farmers or was against them. Independent MLA Nayan Pal Rawat, who is supporting the Government, hit out at the Congress, alleging "everyone knows that in the name of welfare of farmers, the land of farmers was snatched. They looted farmers with both hands. It is Narendra Modi and Manohar Lal Khattar who took steps for peasants welfare and in this context these farm laws were brought."

Haryana CM defends farm laws

Haryana Chief Minister Manohar Lal Khattar on Wednesday said the State Government would continue to procure crops on Minimum Support Price (MSP) as earlier and the market system will continue in the State and would

be further strengthened.

Replying before voting on the no-confidence motion moved by the Congress party during the ongoing budget session here, Khattar said that the three new agricultural laws of the Central Government and the market system will continue in the State and would

from the very first day of our Government, we have taken care of the interests of every section of the society, be it farmers, employees, youth, traders, labourers and have taken a number of welfare decisions for them. In the first two years of our government, we have been under the ambit of Bhavantar Bhaari Yojana. He said as against the target of setting up 1000 FPOs in the state, 486 FPOs have already been formed. Apart from the 1,07 lakh farmers have been registered under the Pashudhan Credit Card Scheme started on the lines of Kisan Credit Card Scheme. He said that a special campaign has been launched in four districts of the state to promote the Scheme for water conservation. Under this, a provision of subsidy up to 85 percent has been made for the purchase of Micro Irrigation equipment so that the precious water could be saved. Similarly, provision has been made to give 75 to 85 percent subsidy on agricultural implements.

On farmers' agitation, Khattar said farmers are our brothers irrespective of the State. In this year, the force could be used against them in any circumstances. He said that position has miserably failed to contribute in maintaining democratic values.

He warned the Congress party that their political grasp is being eroded. It is my moral responsibility to take care of 2.80 crore people of the state, he added.

AYUSHMAN BHARAT SCHEME Punjab Unearths big scam worth crores of rupees

Punjab Vigilance Bureau on Wednesday claimed to have unearthed a big scam worth crores of rupees under the Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana - 'Ayushman Bharat' scheme, in which the State's private hospitals have obtained health insurance claims from insurance company, IFCCO-TOKIO, on the basis of 'fake bills' for treatment of beneficiaries possessing smart health cards.

Contrary to this, the IFCCO-TOKIO had rejected hundreds of insurance claims pertaining to Government hospitals. The Vigilance Bureau BK Uppal said, "On the basis of inputs received from credible sources, it has come to light that several well-known private hospitals — based in Jalandhar, Hoshiarpur, and Kapurthala — have prepared fake bills on the names of smart card holders for their treatment under Ayushman Bharat scheme and took insurance claims from IFCCO TOKIO," said the state Vigilance Bureau BK Uppal.

He said that a regular vigilance enquiry have been registered by the Bureau to investigate this scam worth crores of rupees in the State.

Revealing details of the preliminary findings, Uppal said that Vigilance Range, Jalandhar, SSP Daljinder Singh Dhillon have unearthed this fraud in which several fake medical

bills of private hospitals had been cleared by the insurance company, while the reimbursement bills forwarded by the Government hospitals were rejected.

In this connection, major negligence has been seen at the end of concerned Deputy Medical Commissioners and doctors of the state hospitals or primary health centres," he said.

The major reason for rejecting the insurance claims of government hospitals by the company was to get extraordinary financial benefits of Rs 52,06,500. "As a result, the Punjab Government has suffered a total financial loss of Rs 52,06,500. Then, IFCCO TOKIO insurance company reimbursed the claimed amount to the tune of Rs 1,86,59,150 to the said hospital," he said.

Revealing the modus operandi of the administration of the hospital under investigation (name withheld not to hamper investigations), the

Vigilance chief further informed that a patient named Parmjeet Kaur of Turna village in Jalandhar district was admitted to the hospital for operative gall bladder stone but due to her personal reasons, she did not undergo the operation.

In this regard, the hospital prepared a fake medical bill of Rs 22,000 for this patient and took reimbursement claim form IFCCO-TOKIO under the Ayushman Bharat health insurance scheme," he said.

Citing another case, Uppal said one Sukhinder Kaur of Sidhupur village was admitted to the same hospital for gall bladder operation. "She presented her smart health card issued by the Punjab Government. The Hospital director also rejected during the last one year by the IFCCO-TOKIO health insurance company. The amount of rejected insurance claims of private hospitals is approximately Rs 5,59,96,407. The YP has also identified that 1,015 claims, of approximately Rs 52,06,500, of 35 Government hospitals were rejected during last one year by IFCCO-TOKIO.

Uppal said that to cover up the "fraud", the Hospital shock fake videos of Sukhinder's family members lying on patient beds and took their signatures on blank papers. The Hospital administrator also instructed them to reply on the phone call by saying that they underwent an operation. Walkouts, strikebat, unanimity, passage of Bills mark last day

The last day of the Punjab Vidhan Sabha's last budget session of the current Congress Government on Wednesday witnessed hectic activity with the opposition—Shiromani Akali Dal and Aam Aadmi Party—harsh in its attack against the Government.

SAD staged two separate walkouts — one in protest against the mistreatment meted out to the protesting Anganwadi workers that too on the International Women's Day, and another against the 'lies' of Finance Minister Manpreet Singh Badal.

AAP MLAs STAGE WALK-OUT OVER IMPOSITION OF NEW TAX
